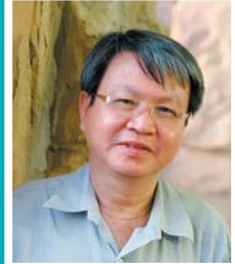

# Course Faculty



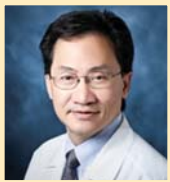
**Ryan Ponnudurai** acquired his MD from Ireland and certified as American Board of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology from US. He gained his endoscopic experience from many famous endoscopists, Nib Soehendra and Gregory Haber. His main interest are all kinds of therapeutic endoscopy and EUS. He currently works for Gleneagles Intan Medical Center, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia the advance and referral hospital. He is also held the position as a president of Malaysian Society of Gastroenterology and Hepatology.



**Khean Lee Goh** is Professor of Medicine at the Medicine Faculty of the University of Malaya in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and Head of the Division Gastroenterology and Hepatology. He received his MBBS from the University of Malaya following medical and surgery studies in Malaysia and also his doctoral degree from the same University He was a Senior Fellow in gastroenterology and advanced therapeutic gastrointestinal endoscopy at the University of Amsterdam. He held several key academic positions within the University of Malaya and served on many national and international professional bodies and committees. He sits in the council of the Asian-Pacific Association of Digestive Endoscopy, and the Asian Pacific Association of Gastroenterology of which he is Vice President. After specialization in internal medicine he focused mainly on gastroenterology, hepatology and therapeutic endoscopy resulting in numerous publications. He extensively worked in education and research and is Editor Emeritus of Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology and a member of various editorial boards including of the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Journal and the Helicobacter Journal. Khean Lee Goh is President and Organizing Chairman of the APDW 2010.



**Takao Itoi** is a young endoscopist who has experience as a master. He graduated from Tokyo Medical University and has maintained his current position as a clinician and researcher in hepatobiliary and pancreatic endoscopy. He has published more than 60 articles in world leading GI endoscopy journals including GIE and Endoscopy. He always presents to the public with a great innovative idea of GI Endoscopy, perhaps we may call him as an incredible endoscopist.



**Simon K. Lo, MD** is Director of the Pancreatic and Biliary Diseases Program at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. Dr. Lo is also an Associate Clinical Professor of Medicine at the David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). Board certified in internal medicine and gastroenterology, Dr. Lo's interests include the diagnosis and management of pancreatitis, pancreatic cancer and bile duct diseases. He is an expert in ERCP, endoscopic ultrasound and a variety of specialized endoscopic technologies. Dr. Lo is a member of several professional organizations, including the American College of Gastroenterology, American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy and International Hepato-Biliary-Pancreatic Association. He has written articles for such peer-reviewed publications as the Annals of Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, Gastrointestinal Endoscopy and Annals of Surgery. Dr. Lo received his bachelor's degree from Queens College, City University of New York, and his medical degree from New York University School of Medicine. After an internship and residency in internal medicine at the UCLA-Wadsworth Veterans Administration Medical Center, Dr. Lo completed a fellowship in gastroenterology at the UCLA Integrated Gastroenterology Training Program and post-graduate training in biliary endoscopy at the University of Amsterdam.



**Jong Ho Moon** is a rising star endoscopist who is working at Digestive Disease Center, Department of Internal Medicine, Soon Chun Hyang University School of Medicine, Bucheon and Cheonan, Korea. He is a very skillful endoscopist and his recent publication on balloon assisted cholangioscopy has attracted others who interested in biliary tract disease to follow. This technique opens the ideas of diagnostic and therapeutic plan under direct visualization of the bile duct.



**Benedict Devereaux** is one of the young promising endoscopists from Australia. He received his advanced endoscopic fellowship on EUS and ERCP from Indiana University. He has published research on the role of EUS on cystic pancreatic mass. He is currently a faculty member at Royal Brisbane Hospital and has recently joined the Asian Pacific Endoscopic Master Forum.



**Dr. D Nageshwar Reddy** is Chairman of the Asian Institute of Gastroenterology, which is a tertiary care gastro intestinal specialty hospital in Hyderabad, India. He graduated from Kurnool Medical College (KMC), India, obtaining his internal medicine Masters in Madras Medical College (MMC) and his D. M. in gastroenterology at the PGIMER in Chandigarh. He was Professor of Gastroenterology at the Andhra Pradesh Health Sciences. Today he enjoys international recognition as an outstanding gastrointestinal endoscopist, reflected by being visiting professor at some of the world's most prestigious universities including those in the USA and Europe. He received several national and international awards for outstanding work in gastrointestinal endoscopy. He was elected an honorary member of American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy in the year 2004. He received the Master's Endoscopy award of American Society of Gastroenterology (ASGE) in year 2009. He was elected a fellow of Royal College of Physicians of Ireland, Fellow of National Academy of Medical Sciences 2001, New Delhi, India. He received India's highest civilian award Padma Sri in the year 2001. His research areas include genetics of Tropical Pancreatitis, Pancreatic-Biliary Endoscopy and NOTES. He has published around 200 papers in peer reviewed journals and has authored several chapters in the text book. He is a member of Editorial board of several journals including Gastro Intestinal Endoscopy, Indian Journal of Gastroenterology, World Journal of Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy. He is the associate editor of text book of Gastroenterological Endoscopy



**Dr Sundeep Punamiya** is currently a Senior Consultant Radiologist at Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore. He graduated from the GS Medical College and KEM Hospital, Mumbai, India. He completed his Radiology residency and Interventional Radiology training in Mumbai, and continued to work at the Bombay Hospital, Mumbai until his recent relocation to Singapore in 2007. An interventional radiologist, Dr Punamiya has a special interest in hepatobiliary disorders, especially portal hypertension, Budd Chiari syndrome, liver tumours and biliary disease. He has performed more than 250 TIPS, including complex situations like acute portal vein thrombosis, portal cavernoma, Budd Chiari syndrome and polycystic liver disease. He is also the recipient of the Distinguished Faculty Award at the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Society of Interventional Radiology in New Orleans. He has also been a reviewer for the CardioVascular and Interventional Radiology, amongst others. He is a frequent speaker and workshop faculty for meetings throughout the world. He has held positions in the Indian Society of Vascular and Interventional Radiology as Joint Secretary and Vice-President, and is currently Secretary of the CVR section of the Singapore Radiological Society.



**Dr Christopher Khor** went to medical school at the National University of Singapore, and went on to train in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology in Singapore. A Health Ministry scholarship led to an advanced fellowship in ERCP and Endoscopic Ultrasound at the Medical University of South Carolina. After completing the fellowship at MUSC, Dr Khor moved to Indiana University Medical Center to further his training in Endoscopic Ultrasound. Dr Khor's main practice areas are in general gastroenterology, therapeutic endoscopy and pancreato-biliary disease. His areas of clinical and research interest are in Endoscopic Ultrasound, ERCP, Therapeutic Endoscopy, New Endoscopic Imaging Modalities and Gastric Cancer. He also has an active interest in computer applications in medical practice, and serves as chair of the Mobile Computing Workgroup of the National Healthcare Group. He has a keen interest in endoscopic training and education, and in addition chairs NUH's House Officer Training Committee. Dr. Khor is currently President-Elect of the Gastroenterological Society of Singapore
